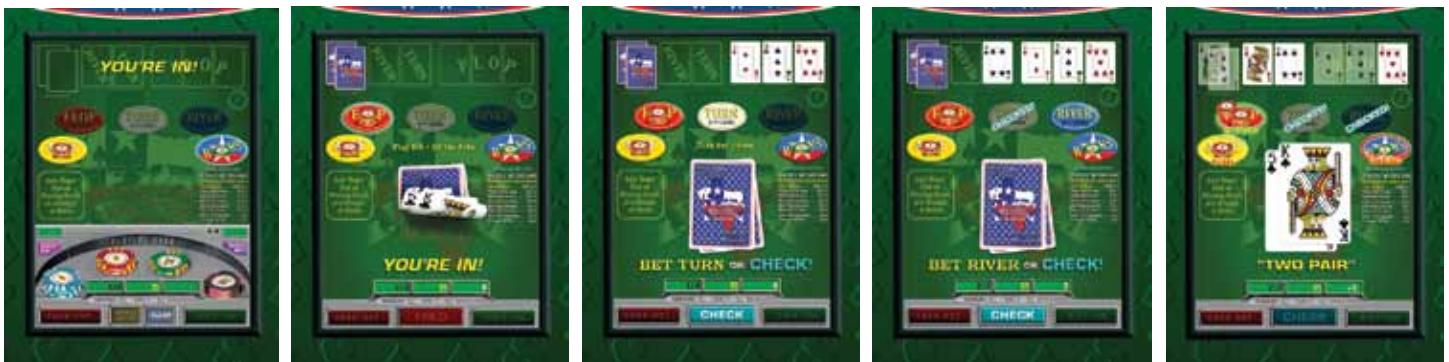
### Exciting Side Bet!

Texas Hold'em Bonus is now available on the DTS platform in a live chip or full virtual version. The standalone DTS-C live chip version gives you all the benefits of a fast, secure, digital game platform while still using traditional chips and a dealer. Or, go to the next level and play Texas Hold'em Bonus on the DTS-V all virtual platform, where both the cards and chips are virtual and you're connected to your SAS backend system for complete player tracking and game monitoring. Use bills or tickets to buy in with a table host and play in fully hosted, semi-hosted or auto-host mode. Both platforms offer the player large 12-inch touch screen displays that provide a great view of all the game action as well as the player's complete bank and betting information. When it's time to place a bet, a simple touch of the on-screen virtual chips allows the player to quickly make their desired wager. Friendly status graphics help keep the player updated on all the game play.

## How to play...Texas Hold'em Bonus™



### Any two cards can win!

The round begins with the players placing an Ante bet (based on table limits). Players may also place a Hole Card Bonus wager; where players compare their starting hand (hole cards) to a posted pay chart (see chart). All wagers (Ante, Flop, Turn and River) are made by the players before receiving or viewing cards, each step of the way. When everyone is in, two cards are dealt face down to each player and the dealer. Players can now peek at their hole cards. Players must decide whether to place a "Flop" bet (2 times their Ante bet) or Fold. After players have bet or folded, three community cards (the Flop) are dealt face up. Players now have the option of betting (equal to the Ante bet) or checking the next community card (the Turn). The 4th community card is dealt face up. Players now have the option of betting (equal to the Ante bet) or checking the next community card (the River). The 5th community card is dealt face up. At the end of the round, each player's best five-card hand is highlighted and resolved as well as any Hole Card Bonus wagers.
